

Information Regarding the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) for IRB-FY2022-6461

This research study may collect personally identifiable information about you, if you choose to give us your email address. As indicated, the Principal Investigator of this study is Prof. Samuel Bowman, Center for Data Science, New York University. New York University and the Principal Investigator are jointly responsible for the conduct of this research study. New York University will act as the data controller for this study and is responsible for looking after your information and using it properly. Should you choose to disclose your email address, NYU will keep identifiable information about you for 1 year after the close of the study.

You have the following rights over the personally identifiable information collected about you during this study:

- The right to request access to the personally identifiable information that the researchers have collected about you, as well as the right to request correction of any information that is inaccurate or incomplete.
- The right to request a copy of your identifiable information in electronic format so that you can transmit the data to third parties, or to request that the researchers directly transfer your personally identifiable information to one or more third parties.
- The right to request that your personally identifiable information no longer be used for the purposes of this research, including if you withdraw from this study.
- The right to request erasure of your personally identifiable information, as well as the right to restrict processing to certain limited purposes where erasure is not possible. To ensure integrity of the study, your information may not be erased where this would render impossible or seriously impair the purposes of the research.

If you agree to participate in this study but later change your mind, the researchers will keep the information about you that they have already obtained, unless you request otherwise. After you have agreed to participate in this study, your rights to access, change, move, erase, or object to the continued use of information already collected about you may be limited, as the researchers need to manage your information in specific ways in order for the research to be reliable and accurate. To safeguard your rights, the researchers will use the minimum personally-identifiable information possible.

The researchers' legal basis for the collection and use of personally identifiable information about you is their legitimate interests in the collection of reliable and accurate data for scientific analysis.

Your data will be processed by Microsoft forms on behalf of New York University. This platform is compliant with GDPR requirements.

New York University is a global university headquartered in the United States. If you agree to participate in this study, your personally identifiable information will be transmitted directly to NYU researchers in the United States. Data protection laws in the United States may not be as strong as the laws where you reside.
